

Off Licence

Issued under Sections 17 to 20, and 64 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



Licence No: 73/OFF/97/2025

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **Thekken Distillery Limited** is authorised to sell alcohol, on the premises situated at **162 Rockdale Road, Invercargill** and known as **THEKKEN DISTILLERY** to any person for consumption off the premises, and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

ENDORSEMENTS

The Licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

Conditions:

- (a) **No alcohol is to be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on ANZAC Day, or between the hours of 11.00pm and 6.00am on the following day.**
- (b) Thekken Distillery will only sell products manufactured by Thekken Distillery.
- (c) Alcohol may only be sold via the Thekken Distillery website, where the website will include a tick box that he or she is 18 years of age or over, before entering the website and before the sale of alcohol.
- (d) The licence must take all reasonable steps to verify that the buyer (receiver) of any alcohol is not under the purchase age and ensures that this gets received by the person who purchased only (including checking a valid ID).
- (e) The licence must take all reasonable steps to verify that the buyer (receiver) is not intoxicated (including training the delivery person in identifying intoxication).
- (f) The delivery package must include a label warning stating the following:
 - i. Package contains alcohol product.
 - ii. Do not leave at destination without the proof of delivery.
 - iii. Only leave with persons who bought the alcohol or who is directed to.
 - iv. Do not leave with persons under 18 years of age. If the receiver appears to be under the age of 25 years, check valid identification (current passport, current New Zealand drivers' licence or current Hospitality NZ 18+ card or current Kiwi Access Card 18+) to ensure the receiver is over the age of 18 years.
 - v. Do not leave with intoxicated persons.
- (g) A copy of or a link to the licence must be displayed in a prominent place on the website.
- (h) Every receipt must contain the licence holders name, licence number, and the date on which the licence expires.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:
